Prof. (Dr.) Praveen Aggarwal has been working in the Department of Emergency Medicine for the past 32 years at All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), New Delhi and is currently serving as Professor and Head, Department of Emergency Medicine at AIIMS, New Delhi.

Honors:

Prof. Aggarwal has been awarded WHO Fellowship in Toxicology in USA and is a Member, Scientific Body, Indian Pharmacopoeia Commission. He is also Co-Chairman, Data Safety Monitoring Board for Clinical Trials Involving Stem Cells, All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), New Delhi, Vice-President, Academic College of Emergency Experts in India and Chief Editor of the Journal of Emergencies, Trauma and Shock.

In 2011, he was awarded the prestigious Fellowship of the Academic College of Emergency Experts in India.
