

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

1. Healthcare Professionals Looking to Transition into Management

- Doctors, nurses, and allied health professionals who wish to shift from clinical roles to administrative and managerial roles.
- Those aiming to lead hospitals, clinics, or healthcare organizations.

2. Graduates Interested in Healthcare Administration

- Individuals with a background in life sciences, healthcare, or related fields who want to specialize in hospital management.
- Fresh graduates seeking a career in healthcare operations and administration.

3. Mid-Level Managers in Healthcare Settings

SELECTION:

1. The number of seats for the Master of Hospital Management course is 30 (Thirty) seats out of which 10 (Ten) seats are reserved for in-service candidates. The short listed candidates will be called for interview. Final Selection will be made on the basis of marks obtained in qualifying exams and interview to be conducted by the Selection Committee comprising of members from SSUHS. The inservice candidates shall have to submit NOC from the Government of Assam/Competent authority while applying.

ELIGIBILITY:

1. Master of Hospital Management (MHM);

A candidate must be Graduate in MBBS/BDS/B.Sc Nursing/ with minimum aggregate of 55 % or above and 50% for reserved categories.

DURATION OF COURSE:

 Master of Hospital Management (MHM): 2 Years (i.e. four semester) inclusive of Internship & Dissertation in the 4th Semester.

FEES STRUCTURE:

- 1. For Master of Hospital Management (MHM): Rs. 65,000 /- (Rupees sixty-five thousand only) per semester. University Registration fee & exam fee shall be as per rates of MD/MS courses.
- 2. Stipend: There shall no provision of stipends for the students.

THE FACULTY:

PEDAGOGY:

For all Modules, emphasis would be given on the usage of technology as applicable.

The language for the course will be English.

PRACTICAL ASSIGNMENTS:

The participants can do their practical assignments in any of the hospitals approved by the SSUHS. They can also do their assignments in an NABH Certified or Accredited Hospitals/ Labs (as applicable and depending on their topic). For every 5 participants, there will be a Mentor who will monitor and guide them in their practical assignments. Evaluation will be done periodically and the participants will have to submit a quarterly report to the Mentor for their progress and





assignments.

CERTIFICATION:

A participant on successful completion of the course is eligible for a Certificate issued by the SSUHS.

CAMPUS INTERVIEW:

After completion of the course, the University will hold Campus Interview for the passed out students where reputed Regional, National & International Health establishment will be invited.


