EDUCATIONAL NOTICE

ENTRANCE EXAMINATON FOR ADMISSION INTO B.Sc. NURSING COURSE IN BOTH THE GOVERNMENT AND PRIVATE INSTITUTES OF ASSAM FOR THE SESSION 2025

In pursuance of the Assam Gazette Notification No. MER. 206054/786 dated 07-11-2023 and No. MER. 488929/19 dated 26-07-2024, the Entrance Examination for selection of candidates for admission into B.Sc. Nursing Course in both the Government and Private Institutes of Assam for the session 2025 is scheduled to be held on 22-06-2025. Online Application Forms shall be available on University website from 23-04-2025 to 22-05-2025.

A requisite entrance examination fee (non-refundable) shall have to be paid by the candidates only in online mode through the paymet gateway available in the University website. The above examination fee is exempted for PwD (Divyang) category of candidaes having disability of 40% and above.

The details of the Entrance Examination including eligibility criteria and requirements shall be available at the University website.

The Entrance Examiation will be held in the centres of Guwahati, Dibrugarh, Silchar, Jorhat, Barpeta, Tezpur, Diphu, Lakhimpur, Nagaon, Kokrajhar, Nalbari, Dhubri, Shillong, Aizawl, Itanagar, Agartala, Imphal, Dimapur and Gangtok. Finalization of examination centres in the state capitals of other North – Eastern states will depend on the number of applicants applying for respective state capitals for appearing in the examination.

Admit Cards will be available online from 02-06-2025 which can be downloaded after log in.

The online application Form must be filled up after carefully going through the instructions given along with the Form. Candidates are strictly advised to keep record of the Application Number and Password used by them while submitting the online form, without which they will not be able to download Admit Cards.

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DETAILS OF THE B.SC. NURSING ENTRANCE EXAMINATION, 2025

- 1. The Entrance Examination shall be held on 22-06-2025 (From 10AM to 12 Noon)
- There shall be 1 (one) paper consisting of 100 objective type Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) of Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English.
- 3. Questions shall be of HS (10+2) Science standard.
- Distribution of marks will be: Physics 25 marks, Chemistry 25 marks, Biology (Zoology and Botany) – 25 marks and English – 25 marks.
- 5. Merit shall be prepared based on the total marks obtained by each candidate in all the subjects i.e. Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English.

If two or more candidates secure the same marks in the Entrance Examination, the inter-se merit of such candidates shall be determined in order of preference as follows:

- a. Candidate securing more marks in Biology in Entrance Examination.
- b. Candidates securing more marks in Chemistry in Entrance Examination.
- c. Candidates securing more marks in Physics in Entrance Examination
- d. Candidates securing more marks in English in Entrance Examination
- e. If it further tallies then marks obtained in Biology, then Chemistry, then Physics, then English of qualifying examination (HS) shall be considered at the time of counselling.
- 6. The minimum qualifying criteria/cut off score in the Entrance Examination of B.Sc. Nursing Course will be as follows:
 - I. For Govt. Institutions:
 - a. General (UR/EWS) 30th Percentile
 - b. SC/ST/OBC (NCL)/ Divyang 20th Percentile
 - II. For Private Institutions (For 50% Management Quota Seats):
 - i. General (UR/EWS) 20th Percentile
 - ii. SC/ST/OBC (NCL) 18th Percentile
 - iii. Divyang 15th Percentile
 - III. For Private Institutions (Rest 50% seats):
 - i. General (UR/EWS) 18th Percentile
 - ii. SC/ST/OBC (NCL) 15th Percentile
 - iii. Divyang 15th Percentile

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- B. The eligibility criteria for appearing in the entrance test and for admission into B.Sc. Nursing Course are as follows:
 - 1. Applicant must be a citizen of India.
 - 2. Candidate must have passed Higher Secondary (10+2) Science or Equivalent Examination from recognized Board/Council/University with English as one of the subjects and securing at least 50% marks aggregate in Physics, Chemistry and Biology for General Category candidates, 45% for PWD Candidates and 40% for candidates belonging to SC/ST(P)/ST(H) category without grace marks.
 - 3. Candidate must be minimum of 17 years on 31st December of the year in which admission is sought.
- C. Reservation of seat: There shall be reservation of seats in Govt. Institutions for SC/ST(P)/ST(H)/OBC (NCL)/TGL/Ex-TGL/EWS/PwD (Divyang) category from the available seats as per Govt norms.

IMPORTANT: It is the responsibility of the applicant to furnish all information correctly. Any information given by the applicant if found to be false or any ineligibility criteria detected at any stage later on shall make him/her liable to be disqualified from the Entrance Examination with all its associated consequences.

A candidate who desires to be considered under reserved category shall have to furnish original certificate of the concerned category from the Competent Authority at the time of counselling.

A candidate applying under PwD (Divyang) Category will have to produce applicable Certificate from the State Level Medical Board/District Level Medical Board as constituted in persuance of Social Welfare Departments Notification No. SWD.181/96/75 dated 21-06-1990.

As the form is to be submitted online, the candidates are not required to send any document to the Univrsity. All necessary verification/scrutiny of the related documents of the candidates regarding eligibility, reservation etc. will be done at the time of counselling by the concerned authority.

Candidates are strictly asked to keep record of the **Application Number and Password** used by them while submitting the online form, without which they will not be able to download Admit Cards.
